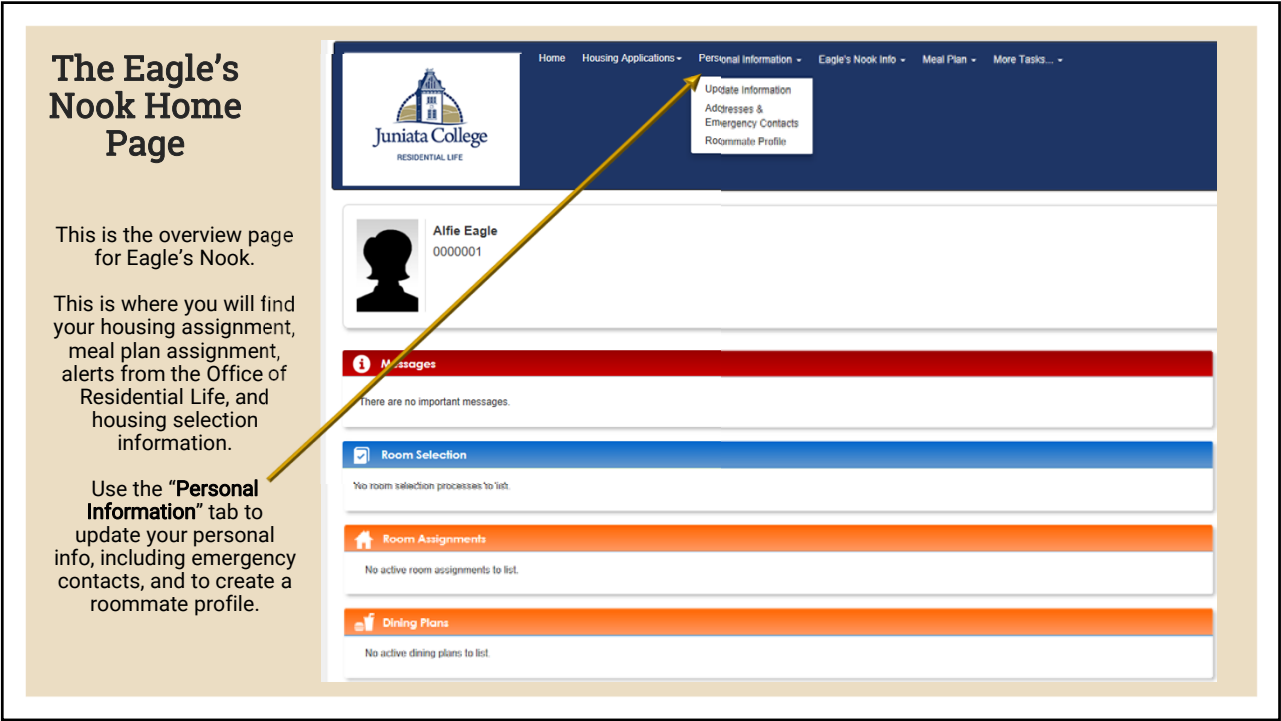
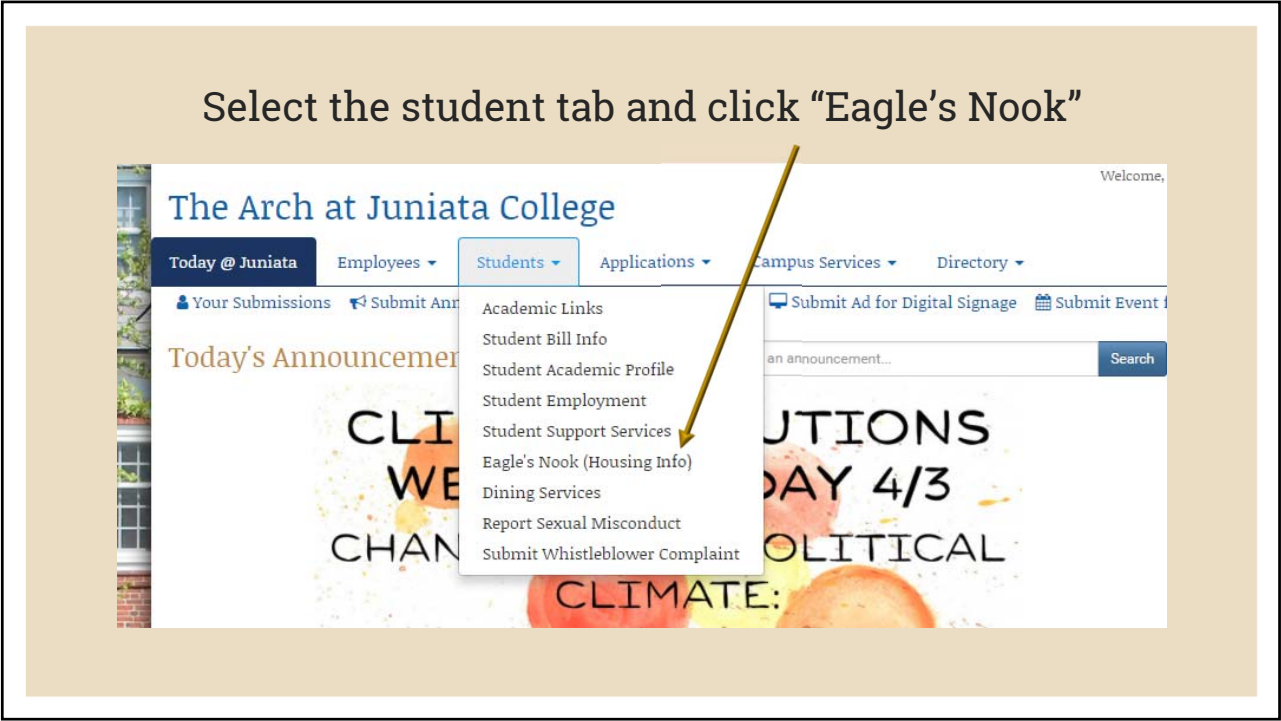

2017-2018

Juniata College is a four-year residential college and all students are expected to live in college-owned housing, unless they are enrolled as a part-time student, commuter, or received approval for a housing exemption. The Office of Residential Life (ORL) seeks to and supports the Juniata mission, especially in the areas of community engagement, personal development, authentic leadership and global citizenship. ORL is committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment that fosters a well-rounded collegiate experience.

This agreement is binding for entire the academic year (each registered semester). In addition to the policies outlined in the *Pathfinder*, students are expected to be adhere to all provisions listed in this agreement.

I. Juniata College:

- A. Will provide each student with a room, furnished with the basic essentials (i.e. a bed, desk, closet, etc.)
- B. Will provide housekeeping services to all public areas within residence halls.
- C. Reserves the right to make changes in room assignments. Changes could occur at any time.
- D. Reserves the right to administer any restrictions or regulations necessary for the maintenance of property, and the general safety and welfare of students.
- E. Respects the basic right to privacy of students, but reserves the right, under provisions of the *Pathfinder*, to enter rooms.
- F. Will close housing units during designated break periods. When college residences are closed, students are not permitted to reside in or enter these areas without authorized permission from ORL. Break housing is limited to designated areas, specified by the housing fee with be incurred for residing in break housing.
- G. Is not responsible for the theft or other loss of money, valuables or personal belongings of residents. Each student is advised to carry personal property insurance.
- H. Does not provide storage for personal belongings. Items left behind will be discarded.

II. Students:

- A. Are assigned specific rooms within college-owned housing. All room assignment changes or status changes must be authorized by the Office of Residential Life. May not transfer or sublet rooms to another person.
- B. Are expected to comply with all specific policies that apply to designated areas. Violations of these regulations may result in disciplinary action.
- C. Are required to participate in an approved college meal plan (if residing in a residence hall).
- D. Are required to sign an inventory form (*Room Condition Report*) upon arrival and are responsible for payment of all damage charges to their room and/or room furnishings (as specified by the college).
- E. Are required to pick up their room key(s) upon arrival and return their key(s) to ORL before moving out. There is a \$100 charge for room keys that are lost or not returned at ORL within 10 days of departure. Are expected to complete college clearance forms when withdrawing from the college and/or leaving college housing during the academic year.
- F. Are required to take break and regulations to outside time.
- G. Are expected to exercise care in the use of college facilities. A damage charge will be incurred in accordance to the college damage policy as outlined in the *Pathfinder*. Damage to property within college-owned housing, but outside of student rooms, will be charged to the student(s) responsible. In cases where no specific individual(s) are found to be responsible for damages, charges will be pro-rated among the residents of the area in which the damage occurred.
- H. Are required to leave college-owned housing within twenty-four (24) hours of completing their last final examination of the semester, unless their exam is on the same day of the college's official closing. In such situations, the final closing hour is also the designated exit time. Students may be charged a fee if they choose to stay beyond these times.
- I. Are required to leave college-owned housing within twenty-four (24) hours of their effective withdrawal date from the college.
- J. May only return early to campus with permission from ORL. Those arriving prior to specified dates without permission will be charged a fee for each day.

THE COLLEGE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TERMINATE THIS AGREEMENT AND TAKE POSSESSION OF THE ROOM AT ANY TIME FOR VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS INCLUDED IN THIS AGREEMENT.

Acknowledgment & Acceptance of Responsibilities

I understand and accept the rules enumerated herein and understand I am responsible for adherence to all other college and borough regulations. I understand that this contract obligates me for the entire academic year (exclusive of break periods) with the exception of withdrawal from school, academic suspension from the college, or acceptance of a study abroad experience. I understand the Office of Residential Life reserved the right to make housing assignments and changes in room assignments for the benefit of the students, or the College.

All requests must be mutual in order for us to assign you together.
